

Do not open an EndNote library from a memory stick or from cloud services like Dropbox, OneDrive, iCloud!



The producer of EndNote warns against opening/running your EndNote library if it is located on a memory stick or on cloud services like Dropbox, One Drive or iCloud. Use your hard disk or server for the EndNote library.

The reason for this is that a memory stick or a cloud service use file compressing during storing and this may cause damage to the library files when opened from these units.

It is safe to use a memory stick or cloud services like Dropbox, One Drive or iCloud to store a back up of your EndNote library. But you need to move the back up to your hard disk or server **before** you try to open/run the back up in EndNote.
