

# How to import references from Cochrane Library

**!** Make a back up of your EndNote library before doing major changes or imports to EndNote

The import filter in EndNote is normally working ok, but you should check imported references as data sometimes is missing or misplaced. Errors can be corrected manually in the library after the import.

Tick the references that you want to send to EndNote **(1)** and choose **"Export Selected Citations(s)"** **(2)**. You can also export all references in the list by choosing **"Select All"** **(3)**. If you are viewing one article, the reference can be exported by clicking **"Cite this review"** **(4)**.

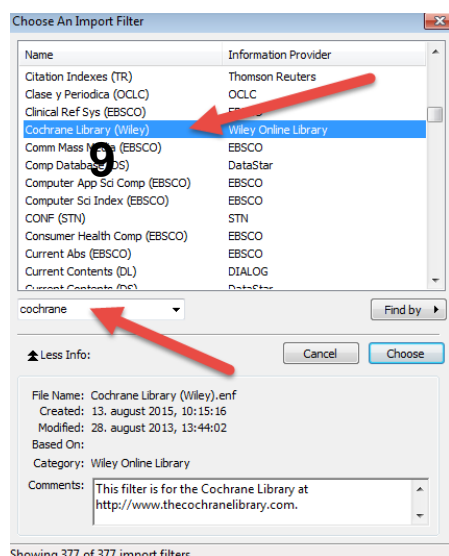
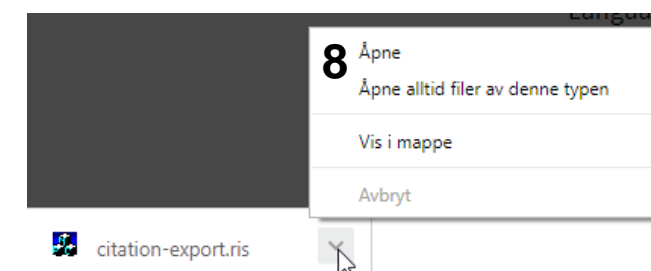
**Print** **Share** **Email**



Choose "**EndNote**" (**5**) and "**Abstract**" (**6**) if you want the abstract included. The choose "**Download**" (**7**).



What happens next is dependent on your web browser. Always choose the "open file" alternative to send the references into EndNote (**8**). Control the imported references afterward to check if all data have been imported correctly.



If you are asked to choose an import filter, choose «**Cochrane Library (Wiley)**» from the list (**9**). Correct import filter is necessary for the import to work properly.

Finish with «**Choose**». The references will now be imported into your library.

The import filter for Cochrane Library is not perfect due to the different types of references in the Cochrane-base, and we recommend that you check the imported references and correct any errors manually afterwards. Just double-click on a references to be able to edit the data.

Click on **"All references"** in the left pane to see all references in the library.
