

The Norwegian University of Science and Technology Publishing Fund

1. Purpose

The purpose of the fund is primarily to provide NTNU researchers who do not have other funding an opportunity to publish papers that have been accepted in fee-based OA journals with a designation of level 1 or 2 in Norway's Database for Higher Education (DBH).

2. Who can apply for funding?

The corresponding author must be affiliated with NTNU via permanent or temporary employment, or as a student, an externally funded research fellow or a visiting scholar before the manuscript is sent to the journal. NTNU shall be listed in the article as the author's institutional affiliation.

3. Which publishing fees are covered?

Support is provided to cover publishing expenses for peer-reviewed articles in OA journals that are listed in DOAJ http://www.doaj.org and whose standard publishing fees are freely available. The journals must be approved at level 1 or 2 in the DBH http://dbh.nsd.uib.no/kanaler/ when manuscripts are submitted, or documentation must be provided that the journal has been submitted for consideration under channel 1 before publishing support will be paid http://dbh.nsd.uib.no/kanaler/nye_kanaler.do

No support is given to articles in journals that are funded through subscriptions, including hybrid journals that use a delayed OA model or offer "Open Choice" models.

Depending on budgetary limits, the fund can cover up to the full fee for articles that are selected for funding, but the maximum amount of support for each author is limited to NOK 20 000 per year. No support will be provided to cover additional fees for coloured photographs or graphics, extra illustrations, etc.

4. Funding requirements

The applicant must show that the journal meets the requirements for support (item 3). The fund does not normally provide support for articles that arise from externally funded projects that have funding to cover the costs of OA publishing.

The article must be registered in Cristin and the published text should be uploaded in Cristin for transfer to DiVA no later than when the article is published in the journal.

5. Applications

Applications for funding should be made on the application form, which can be downloaded from the library's website (URL). The University Library takes up applications continuously and will provide feedback to the corresponding author.

6. Guidelines

In the pilot phase of the fund, policies and practices will be reviewed and may be revised. These changes will not be retroactive, and will be promptly published with the application form. The scheme will be evaluated at the end of 2014 before it is continued.
