<p>The PhD programme offered by the Department of Psychology will provide a basis for an independent, critical and thoughtful perception of one's own and others' research through studying theoretical and methodical subject areas, as well as providing practice in communicating research results in academic and other forums.</p> <p>The courses PSY8010/8011 consist of individually selected texts which enables the adaption of a variety of individually selected research questions. Each course consists of 10 hours of supervision (including preparation and follow-up work for the supervisor). Supervision can be given individually or in groups working on the same topic. Candidates must sign up for the course via the Student Web, but in addition the candidate must get in contact with a supervisor from the Department of Psychology at NTNU.</p> <p>The candidate must hand in a written paper that explains the research questions agreed upon by the candidate and the supervisor. The format of the written paper should be a normal one within the field of study. This usually means that the paper is formed as an article. In some cases it could be more relevant to use another format. The written paper should not exceed 20 pages (A4 with 1.5 line spacing, font size 12 and normal margins without right alignment).</p>
