### Clean Desk Policy:

All our student workplaces at MTP are “clean desk”. Clean desk means that no student will have a permanent workspace and that all desks must be cleared at the end of each day.

### Master Student Workplaces at MTP:

The following rooms are reserved for students who are writing as project or master’s thesis in the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> year of their studies:

**Gløshaugen/Verkstedteknisk/225, 227, 236 and 238.**

Access to these rooms will be given on study program level.

The named student groups can expect to be given access by the end of August 2023. The rooms will be available for you during the fall semester 2023 until the end of spring semester 2024.

### Workplaces for Undergraduate Students:

Our newly renovated “**Kanondekket**” is reserved for undergraduate students, who do not have access to other student workplaces.

### Storage Cabinets:

Storage cabinets are available in 236, 238, outside the PUMA meeting room and outside Kanondekket. You must bring your own padlock.
