What is Linked Data?



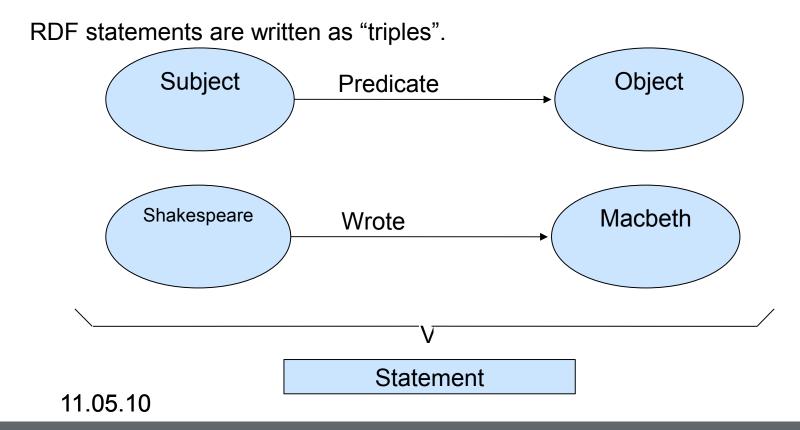
 To employ the RDF data model to publish structured data on the Web.

Data model for writing simple statements about web objects.



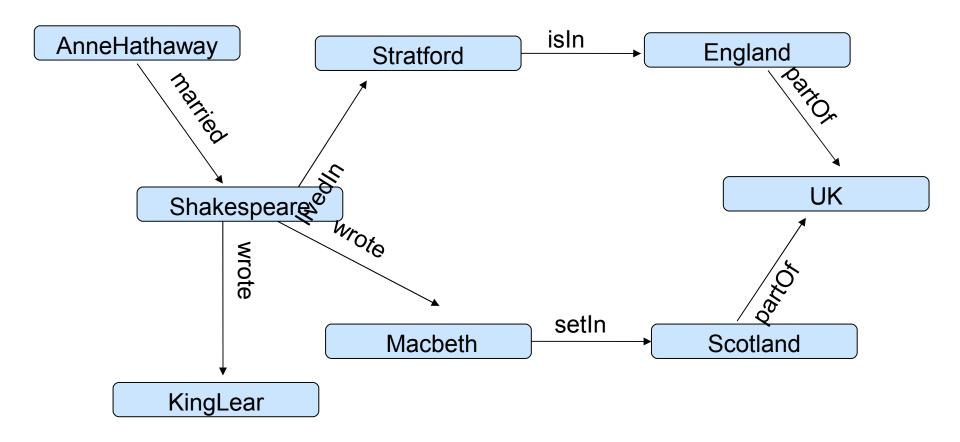

RDF Graph: A Semantic Net



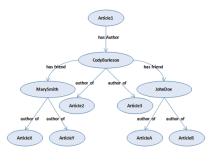


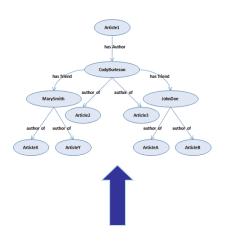

BibTeX to RDF



bibtex2rdf - A configurable BibTeX to RDF Converter

Introduction

Many researchers use LaTeX to prepare their publications. They typically collect bibliographic references in the BibTeX format, because that way LaTeX can generate Reference lists automatically. In BibTeX, each reference is captured as one entry consiting of (tagged) fields. For an introduction to BibTeX see the <u>references</u> section. With the advent of the semantic web, several projects have started to translate this bibliographic information to RDF. bibtex2rdf is a highly configurable translator from BibTeX to RDF which allows to do exactly that. How it works and how to use it is explained in this document.

Usage

The most direct approach to understand how a program works is just to try it. Therefore, we start with the usage section.

bibtex2rdf is provided as jar file (the source code will be published soon). The current version is 1.0 beta 4. Download it here. It is a command line tool and needs a Java JDK/JRE 1.4 as prerequisite. To translate sample.bib to sample.rdf, type java -jar bibtex2rdf.jar sample.bib sample.rdf

The complete call syntax is java -jar bibtex2rdf.jar [-schema <file>] [-baseuri <uri>] [-enc <enc>] <bibtex> [<output>]. For parameter explanation, see the following table. The application generates a log file (bibtex2rdf.log) which contains all warnings and errors.

Ok, I'm interested, what RDFizers are there?

Here is the list of the RDFizers that we have built so far:

- JPEG -> RDF scans a folder for JPEG files, parses the EXIF and IPCT metadata found in those files and dumps an RDF/N3 representation of it into a file.
- MARC/MODS -> RDF transforms MARC records from Z39.2 format into MODS and then from MODS to an RDF representation of MODS.
- OAI-PMH -> RDF harvests an OAI-PMH repository and transforms the captured metadata in an RDF representation thru pluggable XSLT stylesheets.
- OCW -> RDF harvests metadata from the MIT OpenCourseWare web site and transforms it into an RDF representation of IEEE LOM.
- EMail -> RDF transforms email mbox files into RDF/XML.
- BibTEX -> RDF transforms BibTEX files into RDF/XML.
- POM -> RDF transforms Maven POM (Project Object Model) files into RDF/N3.
- DEB -> RDF extracts the metadata from a Debian software package and generates an RDF representation.
- CRW -> RDF extracts the metadata from a Canon RAW image file and generates an RDF representation.
- Flat -> RDF converts classic unix text database files, like /etc/passwd, into RDF/N3.

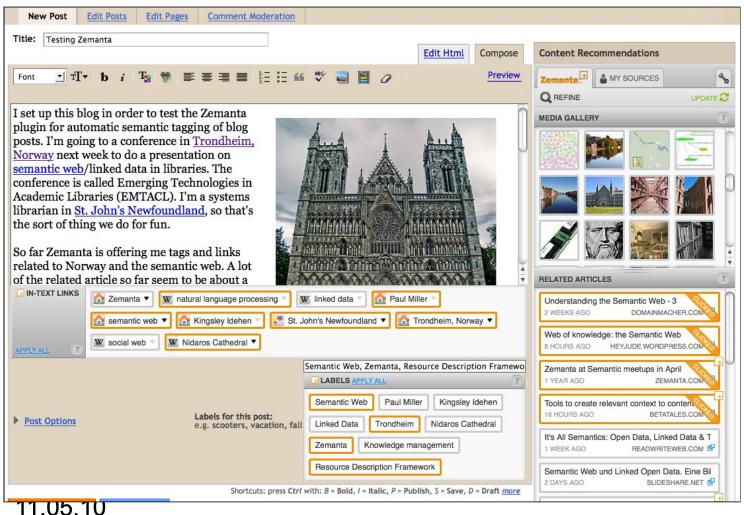

Statement from <u>Mark Patterson</u>: Why PLoS has not signed the Report of the Scholarly Publishing Roundtable

I am grateful to have had the opportunity to participate in the Roundtable on Scholarly

Publishing convened by the Committee on Science and Technology of the US House of

Representatives. I enjoyed the spirited and important discussions. I also appreciated the contributions of all who participated in the Roundtable, under the expert chairmanship of

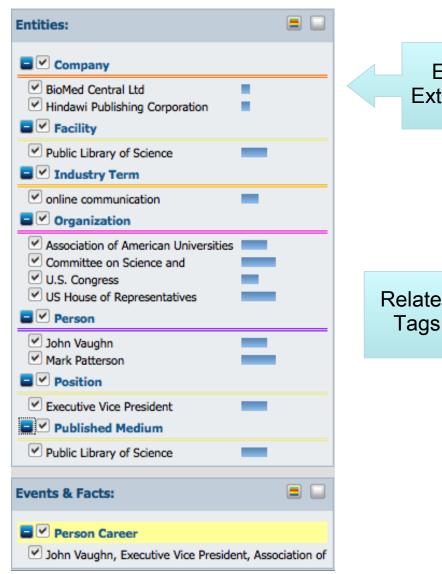
John Vaughn (Executive Vice President, Association of American Universities).

I have not signed the Roundtable Report, though my **Public Library of Science** (PLoS) colleagues and I support many of the principles and goals it endorses. An example of such legislation is the Federal Research Public Access Act, currently under consideration at the **US Congress**, which calls for public access to all federally funded research results no later than six months after publication in a peer-reviewed journal.

Despite these positive attributes, however, the Report does not represent a view of science publishing that PLoS can endorse. It is a consensus statement that stops far short of recognizing and endorsing the opportunities to unleash the full potential of **online communication** to transform access to and use of scholarly literature.

PLoS and other open-access publishers have shown that immediate open access can be achieved. Each year, PLoS now publishes thousands of open-access articles, and has established journals that rank in the top flight of scientific and medical publishing. With the success of PLoS and open-access publishers such as **Biomed Central**, **Hindawi Publishing**

Corporation and others, open-access publishing is now firmly part of the publishing landscape. Moreover, the advent of successful open-access publishing creates opportunities for even more profound changes in the ways scientists work and communicate with each other and the public.



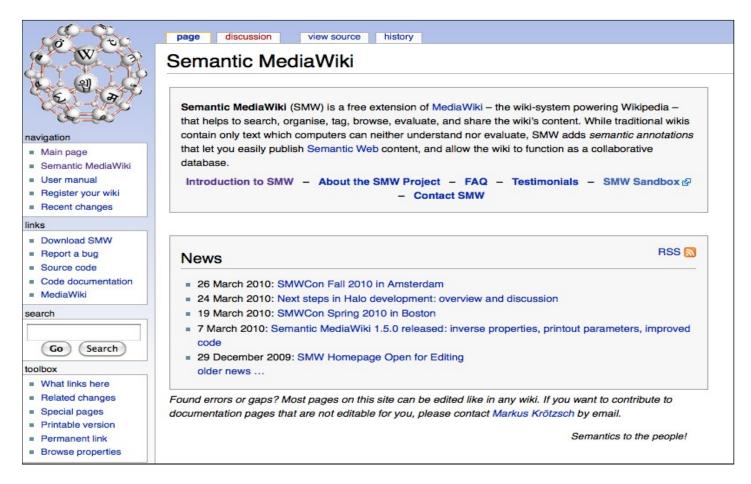

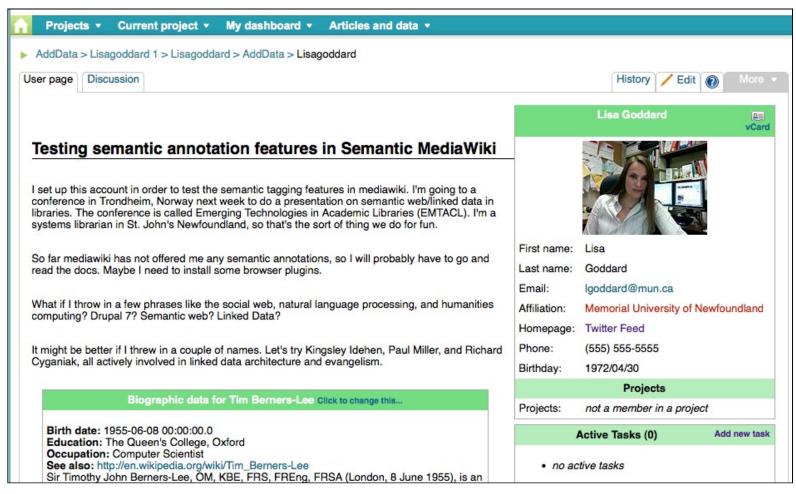

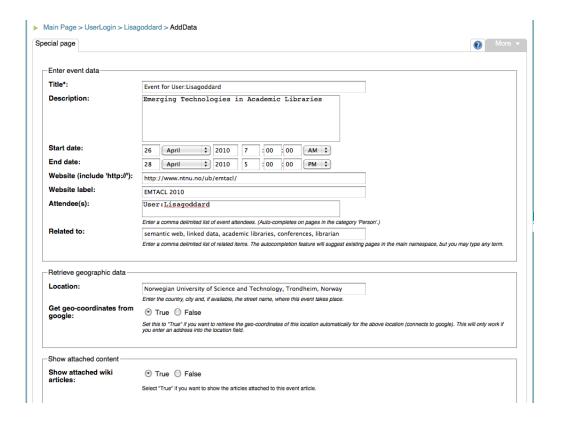

RDF is a W3C standard for modeling and sharing distributed knowledge based on a decentralized open-world assumption. Any knowledge about anything can be decomposed into triples (3-tuples) consisting of subject, predicate, and object; essentially, RDF is the lowest common denominator for exchanging data between systems.

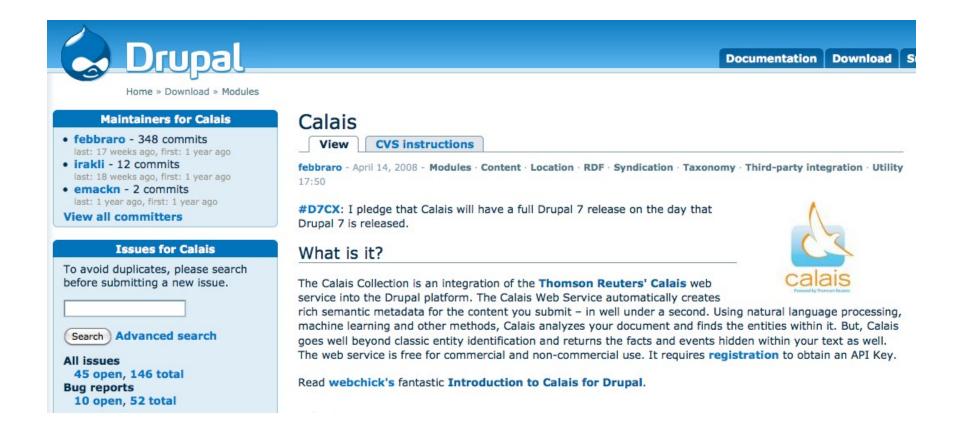

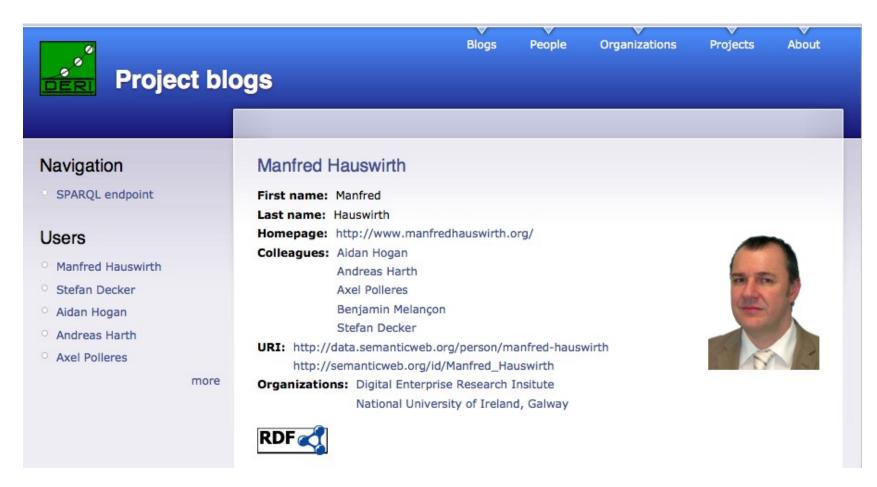
The first alpha release of Drupal 7 will be created next Friday Jan 15th. We've already incorporated most of the feedback we received from the semweb community so far, but I wanted to give the community a last chance to review the RDFa markup and the default RDF mappings we use before it's too late. I should emphasize that all the markup and default RDF mappings that we ship in core will be pretty much set in stone after the stable release of Drupal 7, hence this call for feedback. Site administrators who care about semantics will be able to alter these mappings by installing extra modules, but many people (read several 10K sites) will just install Drupal 7 and not care about the semantics it generates. Therefore we want to make sure the RDFa generated by Drupal out of the box is somewhat correct and does not make folks from the semantic/pedantic web community angry:) - we've tried to keep the semantics as generic as possible for that reason.

I've created a diagram representing the default semantics of the core data structure which has been committed and I would appreciate feedback on the RDF terms we've used.

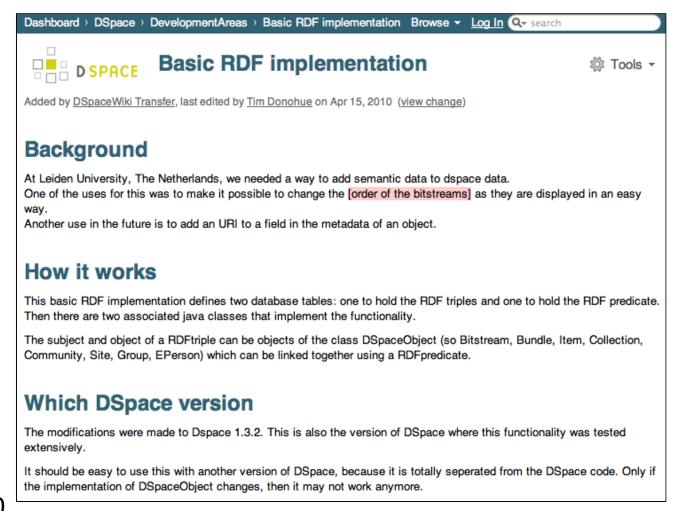

Title: Rishtas: adding emotion to strategy in understanding British Pakistani transnational marriages

Abstract: The popularity of transnational marriages that in most cases involve first cousins or other kin distinguishes Pakistanis from other British South Asian groups. In this article we explain the popularity of such marriages. We seek to complement accounts that stress kinship obligations and socio-economic strategy by showing that transnational marriages are also motivated by the emotional ties of kinship. Central to this analysis is a focus on the Urdu/Panjabi concept of rishta, which conveys ideas about a 'good' match and about emotional connections between people. Our attention to emotional discourse between siblings, between parents and children and between prospective spouses in the context of marriage arrangements augments the understanding of what is at stake for those involved in transnational marriages. Our analysis also complements accounts that emphasize parental exegesis by offering a multigenerational perspective.
